

Do you have any high risk health conditions that make you eligible for the City funded meal program?

The following are considered high risk conditions:

- Smoking
- Diabetes
- Obesity
- Chronic kidney disease
- COPD (chronic obstructive pulmonary disease)
- Weakened immune system from organ transplant
- Serious heart conditions
- Sickle cell disease
- Asthma
- Cerebrovascular disease
- Cystic fibrosis
- Hypertension or high blood pressure
- Immunocompromised state from blood/bone marrow transplant, immune deficiencies, HIV, use of corticosteroids or other immune weakening medicines
- Neurologic conditions
- Liver disease
- Pulmonary fibrosis

The City of New Orleans will provide a COVID-19 Meal Assistance Program, a collaboration with FEMA to qualifying residents. Meals will be provided to a range of vulnerable residents impacted by COVID-19 for 30 days. Call **3-1-1** or go to **nola.gov/311** to apply for meals if you are in any of the following categories and you are not receiving any other federal food support: (no documentation is required)

Seniors age 65 and above; adults with high-risk health conditions and special medical needs; individuals who test positive for COVID-19 or have been exposed; homeless residents; children under 18.
